

THE KEYSTONE AWARD

Nominations for the PSRDF Keystone Award need to be submitted by March 15th to the current PSRDF President.

You can find the updated information for the current PSRDF Presidents on the PSRDF officers page.

Decisions will be made by June 1st by the State Executive Committee and others if appointed by the President. The winner or winners will be announced at the State Convention. Winner need not be present.

The Keystone Award is to be given to individuals or couples who contribute to square/round dancing with up to three awards per year given annually and include a recognition plaque.

Criteria for nominations:

We are looking for individuals or couples who have shown evidence of involvement in at least 6 out of these 10 areas of participation.

1. Square/round dancer/caller/cuer for at least 10 years.
2. Chair or Director for a convention committee (state the years).
3. Involved in the State Federation - attend meetings, hold an office (state the years).
4. Involved in the Local Federation - delegates count (state the years).
5. Officer in their local club (when?).
6. Caller or Cuer.
7. Evidence of promotional and recruitment activities including bringing new members to lessons, participation in demos, organizing events to promote dancing, advertising activities and promoting lessons.
8. Attendance at state conventions(s) (what years).
9. Attendance at national convention(s) (what years).
10. Involved in dancing in and across the country in at least 3 states other than Pennsylvania in the past three years (Give names of dances/dates).

Person(s) making the nomination needs to include their name/address/phone number/e-mail address.

An officer on the Executive Committee cannot be nominated (President PSRDF, 1st VP, 2nd VP, Sec., Treas.). While on the Executive Committee you cannot nominate someone.

A person/couple can be nominated more than once if not selected on the first nomination.

This award can only be received once by an individual/couple. A person/couple cannot nominate themselves.

We have many fine, hard working dancers/callers/cuers in the State of Pennsylvania. We are looking forward to receiving nominations for this prestigious award. The winner(s) will be a secret until announced at the convention.
